CALL TO ORDER:

Supv. Donnelly called the Emergency Meeting to order at 12:30 P.M..

PURPOSE: RESOLUTION # 48 regarding PARKING

PLEDGE:

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited lead by Councilman Gabriel.

SUPV. DONNELLY PRESENTED RESOLUTION # 48

RES. #48 CONTINUING THE PARKING LAWS FROM THE FORMER VILLAGE OF ANDES AS THEY WERE ESTABLISHED PRIOR TO DISSOLUTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF ANDES, as follows:

WHEREAS; the former Village of Andes { “ Village “ } grand fathered certain properties and businesses in regards to parking requirements and;

WHEREAS; the exemption relied upon availability of parking along State Highway 28 and;

WHEREAS; the Town desires to continue to accommodate such residents and businesses lacking parking along State Highway 28 to encourage the enjoyment of the various activities and commerce in the former Village, now Hamlet of Andes and;

WHEREAS; the reconstruction of State Highway 28 has placed signs restricting such grand fathered parking;

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED AS FOLLOWS:

#1. The Parking Laws for the former Village of Andes shall be extended and continued and applied against the Hamlet of Andes in the same manner by the Town of Andes under the authority of the Andes Town Board.

#2. In case of snowfall, other weather emergency or safety considerations, a parking prohibition will be enforced to permit the clearing of snow from State Highway 28.

#3. The Town Board authorizes the Supervisor to remove the parking restriction signs except in cases where they must remain for safety purposes.

#4. The Town Board shall authorize the Supervisor to notify the New York State Police and the Delaware County Sheriff’s Office of such action.
