*Discussed the purchase of a 6x6 plow truck off of the Onondaga County bid versus bidding it out ourselves to see if a lower price could be an option. Bidding ourselves will delay timeline for receiving the truck. Middletown purchased a truck off the bid and they waited a year to receive their truck. If we advertise bids for this it will add at least several months.

*Discussed the purchase of a used mowing tractor. Supervisor Gladstone asked if the board wanted a two year note at 2%. Use earmarked money, from fund balance. To stay debt free

*Discussed the funds for purchasing the equipment. Bonding the truck, partial grant funding, utilizing highway budget funds, insurance money. Supervisor Gladstone stated that after these purchases the purchasing of equipment will have to be limited unless an emergency arises. After 2020 the Highway Department will be debt free, except for the bond that will be needed for the dump truck which will hopefully not have to be paid on until 2022, if it is received in 2021. *Discussed the purchase of a pickup to replace the one regularly used by the Highway Superintendent. Basil Dealership has the State bid, but would have a several month wait. Country Club in Oneonta has the same truck for roughly \$300 more, but they do not have the bid. Should ask Country Club to match the bid. Will have to review the procurement policy to see if this has to be bid or not.

Pool- Rachel Andrews-Pool director has contacted last year's lifeguards and has received positive feedback from most. Discussed the rebuilding or resurfacing of the ramp and the status of the vacuum that will be needed for this summer.

WHEREAS, the Town of Andes' access and operation upon state right-of-way is conditioned upon compliance with Highway Law Sections 52, 103, 203, and/or 234, including the conditions that the Town of Andes assume all responsibility for (a) temporary control of all modes of traffic (including motorized and non-motorized travel) affected by the Town of Andes' operations, (b) complete restoration of state facilities to their condition prior to permitted use or activity, and (c) all claims, damages, losses and expenses;

NOW THEREFORE, in relation to all operations and/or actions undertaken within state right-of-way, the Town of Andes agrees to the terms and conditions set forth in the official undertaking set forth by New York State; and

FURTHERMORE, the Town of Andes hereby warrants that the obligations of this Undertaking are backed by the full faith and credit of the Town of Andes. The Town of Andes may insure or bond any of the obligations, or may rely upon self-insurance, budgeted funds, or funds for general operations.

This Undertaking shall be applicable to all permitted activities and operations undertaken after the date of execution and work initiated while this Undertaking is in effect. This Undertaking may be revoked by the Town of Andes or rejected by NYS DOT upon thirty days written notice but will continue to apply to all permitted activities/operations that were permitted by virtue of this Undertaking. Unless terminated for the purpose of future activities/operation, this Undertaking shall have a term of twenty (20) years and shall be kept on file to facilitate the issuance of future permits to which it will apply; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Supervisor Gladstone is hereby authorized to sign said undertaking to be forwarded to the NYS DOT.
