Commercial Tent Campsites-

Community Solar Campaign-

*Update: our scoping document has been submitted to NYSERDA for approval. This can take a few weeks. Once we receive approval of our application there will be a kickoff event beginning the program. Thank you to everyone who has reached out with support of this project. Please do not sign up until after our kickoff event to ensure that your enrollment will count towards our 10 community participants. The participants must be new to the program as of the start of our campaign.

Stimulus Funds-

*According to Senator Schumer’s Office, the Town of Andes will be receiving roughly \$130,000 in Federal Stimulus Funds. There are many requirements on the utilization of these funds, more information will be provided as we become aware. At this time, it is planned that some funds will be used to reimburse the Town for COVID related expenses.

Other-

*Cell Phones- discussion took place regarding purchasing and providing cell phones for five department heads. The cost of the cell plan quoted is \$225/month with the phones being free as part of that plan.

*Ballantine Park- discussion took place regarding a potential fundraising event for Ballantine Park. The park has always been maintained with donated funds from community members. The board will discuss ideas at the May Meeting.

*A Special Meeting/Workshop will be held on Thursday, April 15th, 2021 at 6PM to discuss the highway department trailer and the Commercial Tent Campsites.

The last time we had to plow and sand was March 17th


Brian had to cut the corners of 2009 dump box due to rust and replace with new steel. The next is the other 09 with the same problem. Mowing is being done along our roads. Please be cautious when passing the tractor. We have started touching up some of the rough spots on our dirt roads fixing washouts and pot holes. The men are disassembling our plow trucks getting ready for spring and summer work. Plows and wings are being painted and put away sanders washed oiled and put in the old shop. Sweeping will begin shortly as weather permits. We know it's dusty from this winter. I called village of Delhi for the sweeping of the Hamlet. As soon as I have a date we will put the word out. Please start to think about other places to park for that time if you park on the street.

Gordon Gardner has left our employment. We wish him the best of luck in his new position.

I have applied for a permit to work on old Gladstone hollow a washout occurred there and the road is very narrow. I hope the work can start on that by the middle of April.

We have been without an equipment trailer since September due to safety issues. Parts seem to be very hard to get. So I am proposing the purchase a new one. We need a 25 ton equipment trailer to move our equipment and the excavator's and bulldozers that we rent we will be doing Fema work along with our normal daily repairs and we need something safe and reliable to work with. I have included a couple of options with a tilt style trailer as our best choice for the type of hauling we do.

AGREEMENT FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF HIGHWAY MONEYS

2021

AGREEMENT between the Town Superintendent of the Town of Arden, Delaware County, New York, and the undersigned members of the Town Board.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 284 of the Highway Law, we agree that moneys levied and collected in the Town for the repair and improvement of highways, and received from the State for State Aid for the repair and improvement of highways, shall be expended as follows:

1. GENERAL REPAIRS. The sum of \$ ~~528,351~~ ^{425,000} shall be set aside to be expended for primary work and general repairs upon 110 miles of town highways, including sluices, culverts and bridges having a span of less than five feet and boardwalks or the renewals thereof.

LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF THE YEAR 2021

TOWN OF ANDES - COUNTY OF DELAWARE A LOCAL LAW TO REGULATE OVERNIGHT PARKING IN THE HAMLET PORTION OF THE TOWN OF ANDES

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF ANDES, DELAWARE COUNTY, NEW YORK, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE AND INTENT

It is the purpose of this Local Law to promote the protection, order, conduct, safety, health, safety and well-being of the residents of Andes and the lands which lie within the Town's borders by regulating overnight parking on public streets during certain months of the year within the Hamlet portion of the Town of Andes. The specific purpose is to allow for the unimpeded clearing of snow and ice within the Hamlet.

SECTION 2. NO OVERNIGHT STREET PARKING FROM NOVEMBER 15 THROUGH APRIL 1

There shall be no overnight parking on any public street within the Hamlet area of the Town of Andes from November 15 through April 1st, nor on any other street posted with signs so designating. For the purpose of this local law, the "Hamlet" area of the Town shall be that portion of the Town enclosed by the former Village of Andes and designated as the "Hamlet" area in the Town Zoning Law.

SECTION 3. PENALTIES

The violation of this local law shall incur a fine of no less than \$50.00 for each violation. Every additional twenty-four (24) hour time period that there is a violation of this local law shall be deemed a separate violation and shall incur an additional fine in that amount for each such violation.

SECTION 4. INTERPRETATION; CONFLICT WITH OTHER LAWS

In their interpretation and application, the provisions of this Local Law shall be held to be minimum requirements adopted for the promotion of the public health, safety, or the general welfare. Whenever the requirements of this Local Law are inconsistent with the requirement of any other lawfully adopted rules, regulations, ordinances or local laws, the more restrictive provisions, or those imposing the higher standards, shall govern.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of New York, together with the posting of this parking regulation within the enforcement area of the Town, all in accordance with the applicable provisions of law, and specifically Article 3, Section 27 of the New York State Municipal Home Rule Law.
