Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 PM

Pledge:

The pledge of allegiance was led and recited

Approval of Minutes:

Motion to approve the March Regular Meeting Minutes made by Councilman Gabriel, seconded by Councilman Hall. All in favor. Motion carried.

Discussion:

-Implementing new Transfer Station permits was discussed. The new plan would come with a yearly fee and prevent non-residents from using the Andes Transfer Station. There will also be rules set in place for Contractors. This plan is expected to be in place by October 2025. The Transfer Station entrances also need to be secured to prevent people from leaving trash there on days the Transfer Station is not open.

-Leaks in the town pool were also discussed. Currently Councilman Gabriel is filling the pool and testing to see how much water is leaking.

Reports:

Supervisor's Report

- Fuel system and electrical upgrades are in the works for the Highway Department.
- Generator Estimates have been submitted by John Huber.
- SWCD (Soil and Water Conservation District) has approved funds to help repair damages from Tropical Storm Debby. Repairs are to be made to The stream behind the Andes Public Library as well as on High street.
- I have met with Highway Superintendent John Bouton to discuss the Shared Service Agreement with Andes School Representatives. The school district uses the town's fuel for school busses. The school is responsible for 50% of the system maintenance costs for the fuel system.
- Zachary Haverly has been hired to fill the position of Andes Code Enforcement Officer.

Highway Report

Fuel System Upgrade Estimates:

- American Petroleum is offering a maintenance contract of \$550 annually which includes unlimited phone support and a 10% discount on repairs.
- Old lighting needs to be upgraded to LED lighting in the highway Garage and new outlets need to be installed. ARPA funds awarded in 2022 will be used to pay for this project.
- Generator Estimates from John Huber.

-Comprehensive Plan Vote

The Comprehensive Plan needs to be voted on, but a Public Hearing needs to be held first. The Public Hearing date will be set at the next Board Meeting on May 13th 2025.
