Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Gladstone at 6:01PM

Pledge:

The pledge of allegiance was led and recited by Supervisor Gladstone

Minutes:

Motion to approve the February 2025 Regular Meeting Minutes, made by Councilman Gabriel, Seconded by Councilman Hall. All in favor, Motion carried.

Privilege of the Floor:

*Cyndi Wright discussed the addition of trash receptacles in the Town on Main Street. People who visit town often complain of the lack of garbage cans on the streets. Concerns were raised that animals could get into the receptacles as well as that they can encourage unauthorized dumping such as people bringing house trash or cleaning out their cars. Cyndi suggested containers that could be covered at night or the possibility of taking the containers indoors. Jay Govendo, a Transfer Station employee, has agreed to empty the containers once a week or more as needed. Councilman Hall added a concern that we might need to then hire more Transfer Station employees, which we do not need to do considering the size of the station. There is some chance that local businesses will raise money to fund the project. The matter has been decided to revisit next month.

*Karen Bornarth discussed the possibility of a Noise Ordinance in Andes. She lives next to Wayside Cider and sometimes the noise goes on until late at night. This issue has been explored

before, but with no way to enforce the ordinance it has been abandoned. It was suggested that businesses could self-regulate. Councilman Mondore who also works as the Dog Control Officer for Andes added that if we were to enact a Noise Ordinance, he would then need to also honor the complaints about excessive dog barking and start giving out fines and citations.

Reports:

Supervisor's report

- *I have met with BlueWing Regarding the site for the cell tower. There needs to be an archaeological study done to determine where an effective place for the tower would be.
- *The town will need to take over operations for the Andes Cemetery. The Cemetery Board funds are limited and they have been struggling to keep up with operations. This will be a new line in the budget for next year. The annual cost for the cemetery is generally \$37,000.
- *Michael O'Toole is looking at the possibility of using the RR Depot as a studio for the new radio station he is trying to bring to Andes. We will be meeting with representatives from the food pantry which also operates out of the Depot to make plans.
- *Interim Code Enforcement Officer Josh Morgan is helping to find a permanent COE for the position. Interviews are scheduled and we have 2 prospective candidates. Josh will oversee the process of training the new Officer.

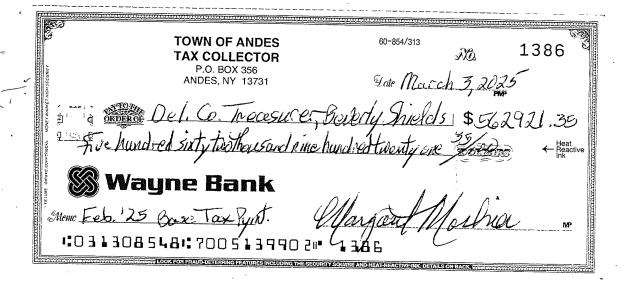

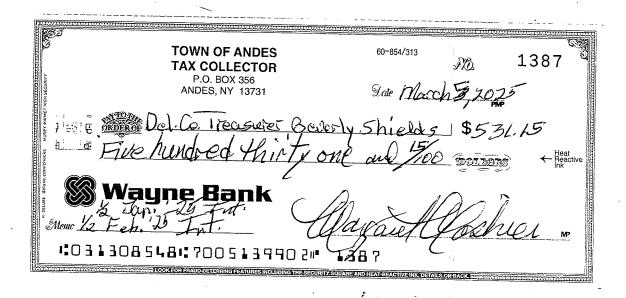

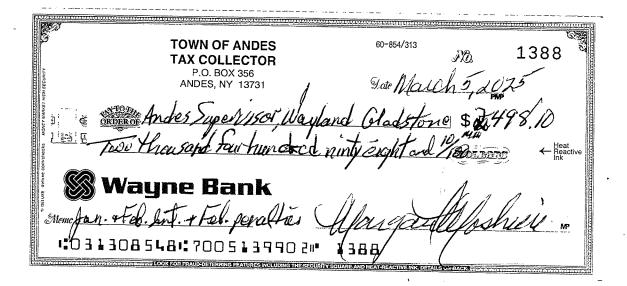
